No information has been received from the Owners or from theelsingfors Surveyor in regard to the Survey due on this Finnish ownedailing vessel.

The case was last before the Committee on the 10th June last when in view of the fact that the vessel was lying in the River Blackwater and was concluded to be laid up, instructions were given for the usual letter of undertaking to be obtained from the Owners. The request for an undertaking could not however, be delivered by the Post Office, and was returned to Wokingham, and according to the Shipping Papers the vessel is still laid up in the River Blackwater.

From information elicited from Lloyd's it would appear that this Finnish vessel was partly owned by A.E. Martin & Co., but the complete ownership is now vested in this firm, whose address is 108, Fenchurch Street, E.C.3. Lloyd's also state that the vessel is at present a hulk.
