Dear Sir,

With reference to the classification in the Society's Register Book of your barque "ALASTOR", I am directed to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them a letter received from the Society's Surveyor at Helsingborg from which it appears that this vessel is still laid up.

In the circumstances I have to state that as the year of grace allowed for the 4th Special Survey No.3 has expired, the Committee can agree to her class in the Register Book remaining undisturbed for the present only subject to the conditions usually required by them in similar cases, viz:- that the overdue survey and all necessary repairs be carried out before the vessel again proceeds to sea, and that you undertake to have this done if she remain your property, and should she be offered for sale to inform intending purchasers that the class is allowed to remain subject to this being done.

I shall therefore be glad to learn that you are willing to agree to these conditions and that you will
