In November the Oslo Surveyors wrote this vessel was loading in Finland for London and was to return thence to a home port to have the survey held. The Committee agreed to this proposal subject to it being adhered to.

On the 29th ultimo the Owner wrote the vessel had arrived in London and was unlikely to complete her season's trading for another two months, by which time the new season would be commencing, and that as she only passed her No.2 survey in 1924 he trusted the Committee would allow the twelve months extension of class to

enable him to have the survey completed at a more convenient opportunity, subject of course to any general examination that the Committee might require to be made in London.

The Owner was informed in reply that provided the vessel were generally examined in dry dock at the present time, all necessary repairs effected and a favourable report received, the Committee would agree to the survey being held sometime within the year of grace.

The Captain was also informed of the Owners decision and in a letter dated the 7th instant he stated the vessel was ready for sea being bound for Helsingborg where she would be laid up for the Winter and he understood the Owner intended to drydock her in this port before recommencing trading next Summer.

N.B. According to the Shipping Papers the vessel left London on the 8th instant.
