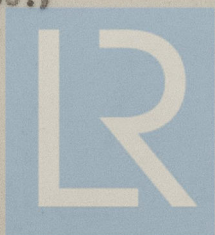
I may say that the Captain of the vessel is being informed of the Committee's decision.
