This vessel was for some time requisitioned by the Admiralty.

In July last it was understood she had become the property of the Ministry of Transport but in February came the information that she had reverted to the Ownership of Dinas Steam Trawling Co. Ltd.

On the 24th February the Liverpool Surveyors stated they had been informed by the Owners that they had not yet made decision whether the vessel would be scrapped or put back to sea. The Owners' definite intentions were to be furnished in due course.

In reply to further enquiry the Liverpool Surveyors now state they have been informed by the Owners that they have not yet come to any definite decision in regard to the future of this vessel.
