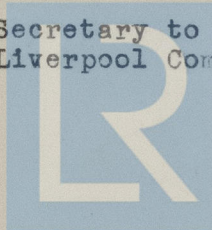
As regards the "WILLIAM HANNAM", they have not yet made a decision whether they will scrap the vessel or put her back to sea, but will advise me of their intentions in due course.
