

Steamer "SINAI"

I telephoned Mr. Landy of the Till Co. (England) Ltd., with reference to his letter of the 2nd instant, and explained that the Swansea Surveyor had stated in his report that ^{he} they did not consider that any part of the Swansea Survey, 10.48 - 1.49, should be considered as part of the Special Survey for classification of the hull, although it was agreed that part of the Machinery Survey had been carried out.

Mr. Landy stated, however, that he and Mr. King, his Swansea Superintendent clearly understood that the parts examined at Swansea had been passed for Special Survey, and he therefore requested that the question should be re-opened with the Surveyors concerned who should be asked to communicate with Mr. King in the matter.
