The remarks of the Chief Ship Surveyor are desired on this case for the consideration of the Classing Committee.

"The endorsement to contain a succinct summary of any repairs that have been required and to show the cause or causes of such repairs, and also to bring out clearly any exceptional features in connection with the case, so that the Classing Committee may have all the salient points presented in the endorsement."—Extract from Sub-Committee's Report, 24/5/92.)

The record (Classification Contemplated) is recorded in the Register Book.

The SWANSEA Surveyors report the vessel examined in dry dock and found efficient for the proposed voyage from Swansea to Genoa. Some keel and bottom shell plates found buckled but riveting in way examined and found tight.

In view of the Owners' proposal to carry out extensive alterations, it is not considered that any part of the present Survey be counted as part of the Classification Survey, and this remains to be dealt with at its entirety on the vessel's arrival at Genoa.

It is submitted NO ACTION be taken meantime.
