S.S. "SINAI"

In reply to your letter of the 18th instant, I have to inform you that provided an external and internal examination be made of the hull of this vessel, sufficiently extensive to enable you to satisfy yourselves of her condition, and she be found or placed in efficient condition for the proposed voyage in ballast, a Certificate 'C' may be issued, subject to the required Special Survey for Classification, including drilling of shell plating, and all necessary repairs, being carried out on arrival at the port of destination. In view of the age of the vessel, you should be completely satisfied with any parts now opened up and examined and recommended as part of the Classification Survey.

It is noted that it is proposed to count the necessary opening out of the boilers and machinery as part Classification Survey, and you should avail yourselves of the opportunity afforded to prepare First Entry Reports on the machinery and electrical installation, and the necessary plans should be submitted for consideration.

A Load Line Certificate will be required for the proposed voyage and you should therefore forward full particulars on Rpts. C.11 and C.11(comp) for freeboard assignment.
