With reference to previous correspondence respecting the above vessel, we have to inform you that the vessel is now in dry dock and Owners representative has requested a survey for the issue of a Certificate to proceed in ballast from Swansea to Marseilles or Genoa.

It is proposed to carry out a minimum of work to make the vessel efficient for the proposed voyage, the necessary opening out of the doors and machinery to be counted as part Classification Survey. Classification Survey on Hull and Machinery is proposed to be completed at the port of destination.

We shall be glad to know if it will be in order to proceed with desired survey and also if a freeboard assignment is required for proposed voyage.





There are at present two rows of side scuttles below the freeboard deck, the lowest sill being about 10' below the freeboard deck of 18' 0" above the keel.
