Dear Sirs,

I have to acquaint you that to complete the Boiler Survey of the steamer "CONTE VERDE" the safety valves of the four boilers in the forward stokehold and of the port boiler in the after stokehold require to be examined. The Trieste Surveyors recommended in August last that the repairs which have been carried out to the boilers by electric welding should be examined before the end of last month.

In reply to enquiry the Owners have informed the Trieste Surveyors that this vessel is at present under survey at your port for damage repairs and that arrangements will be made for the above matters to receive attention on the vessel's return to their port unless they have already been dealt with at Hong Kong.

In the circumstances I await the receipt of your report on the case in due course.
