The class is subject to the items as detailed on the last endorsement.

The Trieste Surveyors report the vessel examined in dry dock, bottom coated, a shoe plate fitted to the keel plate and minor repairs carried out.

The rivetting in keel plates as above has now been renewed and deck house front in forward well satisfactorily faired.

The deck plating over dynamo and under refrigerating space has now been almost completely renewed, together with some beams in way.

A swimming bath has been constructed on the boat deck as per approved plan attached and minor alterations in connection therewith carried out.

It is submitted the vessel is worthy to remain as now classed with fresh record of survey 7.37, subject to the indented plate K.8 starboard side being dealt with at Owners' convenience, but without other condition.
