You may be interested to know that Messrs. Beardmore sent up a motor car for these certificates this morning so you will realise that they were very anxious to get them.

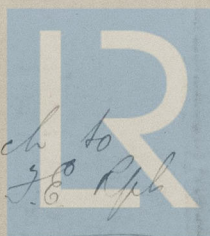
