

Dear Sir,

As desired in your above letter of the 15th instant, addressed to the Glasgow Office, I have to forward attached the first entry report on the Hull of the Motor Tanker "PETRO", Messrs. Ferguson Brothers (Port-Glasgow) Ltd., No. 341, together with the special report on Report Form 22.

I have also to acknowledge receipt of your telegram to Glasgow on the same subject and to confirm having replied as follows by wire last night:-
