I beg to return the 1st. entry report of the steamer "Commander Holbrook" completed in respect of particular of class, and signature, and regret that this was omitted from the report.

With reference to the plan of midship section for this, and the sister vessels now building, the builders intend making a new plan in which the ballast tanks originally intended to be fitted-but now cut out-will be excluded; they are however at present working short handed and have several vessels for the War Office on hand.
