The gunmetal body of the jacket cooling water pump was tested by a hydraulic pressure of 5 Kg./cm<sup>2</sup> and found good and sound.

The cast iron body of the piston cooling water pump was tested by a hydraulic pressure of 10 Kg./cm<sup>2</sup> and found good and sound.




SURVEYOR TO MARCH 1930
