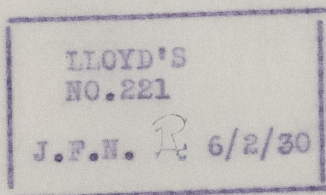

The steam cylinders, valve chest and their fittings
were tested under hydraulic pressure of 14 kgs/cm² with satisfactory
results.

The pump barrels valve box and their fittings were tested
under hydraulic pressure of 15 kgs/cm² with satisfactory results.

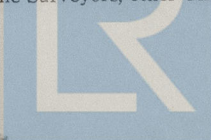
