The S.S. "PORT CURTIS" is expected to be in Liverpool tomorrow, and to complete the \* Lloyds R.M.C. 5-20 survey the following articles of spare gear are to be placed on board:-

- 1 H.P. piston valve.
- 1 Valve spindle and nut.
- 1 Eccentric Rod.
- 1 Set L.P. piston rings.
- 3 Condenser tubes.
- 1 pair crank pin shells with bolts and nuts.
- 1 " main bearing shells.
- 2 Delivery valve seats for compressors.
- 24 Compressor piston leathers.
- 24 " gland "
- 2 leather moulds.
- 8 Brass cased thermometers.
- 2 Brine distribution cocks.

Also please note that to complete the \* L.M.C, 5-20 survey, a perforated iron cover plate is to be fitted over the manhole to the "well" in the Engine Room, adjoining the after bulkhead, at the Port Corner, into which the Bilge Injection Pipe, and two water

circulating drain pipes project.

This cover plate should be studded and fitted with distance pieces in order to leave clear opening between it and the tank top of about 1".
