Nature of Survey .....

The Genoa Surveyors report this vessel examined afloat and both masts above bridge deck cropped and renewed, the lower portions remaining in position as before.

The masts were taken from a warship and are of increased strength.

Test pieces were taken from the new masts and tested with satisfactory results.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed without record of survey.
