

The Havre Surveyors report that a bower anchor of proper weight and test has been placed on board this vessel, 1 length of chain cable repaired and retested and temporary repairs effected to the starboard hawse pipe, which they recommend be renewed at a home port.

The Surveyors further report (form 9) that some rivets in the engine seating have been renewed and additional rivets fitted.

It is submitted the vessel appears worthy to remain as classed, without record of survey, subject as recommended.
