With reference to Trieste first entry report No.7286 on the M.V. "TERGESTEA", Cantiere Navale Triestino's No.157, and to Glasgow Report No.453252 and plan respecting the Cochran Donkey Boiler No.9743, I have to inform you that this Donkey Boiler has been placed on board the "TERGESTEA" by mistake, subsequently replaced on shore without informing us and substituted by the Cochran Donkey Boiler No.9726.
