Arrangement of Safety Valves on Steam Pipe Line
connecting Water Tube and Scotch Boilers.

IT IS SUBMITTED the New York Surveyors be informed
it is noted that the four safety valves on the emergency
pipe line connecting the high pressure water tube boiler
to the main steam line supplying steam to the main engines
at 190 lbs/ins², are of a special type having a stated
relieving capacity of 45,760 lbs of steam per hour.

In the circumstances, these safety valves could be
accepted provided the accumulation tests as specified in
Section 34, Clause 3 of the Rules for Engines and Boilers
be carried out to the Surveyor's satisfaction.
