Nature of Survey **REPAIRS-TO-ENGINES-AND-BOILERS-DUE-TO-DAMAGE-THROUGH**

This vessel was built in 1945 and classed 100 A- "Steam Trawler" "For Government Service". A record of LMC 4.45 was assigned.

The vessel has now been sold to private Owners and a Special Survey carried out.

The pumping arrangements have been modified and an oil fuel burning installation fitted in accordance with the approved plans.

The electrical equipment has also been modified in accordance with an approved plan and a new First Entry report forwarded. Some of the cables, however, are of insufficient capacity for the current carried, and this is the subject of a separate endorsement dated 15. 8. 47.

IT IS SUBMITTED that this vessel is eligible for the Record LMC 5.47, subject to the generator main cables and feeds to the heating circuit being replaced by cables complying with the Rules at the first opportunity.

The Surveyors have recommended a notation of S (OG) 9.46, but as the vessel has been under survey till May last IT IS SUBMITTED for consideration whether a later date might be assigned.

The Surveyors should be advised in accordance with the separate endorsement dated 15. 8. 47.
