Dear Sirs,

I duly received your memorandum of the 11th ultimo enclosing a letter received by you from Sir Alec Black, intimating that it is no longer desired to maintain the classification of the steam trawler "WARLORD".

I conclude it has already been explained to the Owners that, under the provisions of circular No. 1764, the Committee are not insisting upon full compliance with Special Survey requirements at the present time, but before submitting the case to the Committee, I shall be glad to learn whether you have taken this step as it is thought that the Owners might probably feel inclined to maintain class, if the concessions now in general use were explained to them.
