With reference to your letter of the 16th ult. enclosing a statement regarding the above steamer, I have to state that she arrived in this Port yesterday with an R.I. Interim Certificate for the voyage from Rio de Janeiro to Genoa.

I have to-day spoken with Dr. Solda', the General Director of the R.I., who informs me that, following a request from the Owner, instructions were given for a General Examination to be carried out by their Non-Exclusive Surveyor at Santos with a view to issuing an Interim Certificate for the Vessel to proceed to Italy.

^{MACHINERY}
The defects noted in your statement are included in the Report on the case forwarded by the R.I. Surveyor who carried out the Survey at Santos.

Certain repairs were effected to the Boiler which was afterwards tested hydraulically to 180 lbs sq ins, and found tight.

The Safety Valves were adjusted to 135 lbs sq.ins.



It is ^{STA}noted a full reclassification Survey will be carried out at this time by the Surveyors to the R.I.

On account of the age of the Vessel and the fact that she is no longer equipped for carrying refrigerated cargo, the Owner states that it is with great reluctance he has decided not to submit the steamer for reclassification with our Society, and stated that there was also a possibility that the Vessel would be broken up.
