Dear Sir,

We beg to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 16th instant regarding the freeboard marking of the motor vessel "RIALTO" and, in reply thereto, have to inform you that a new statutory deck line has been marked on the vessel's sides at the intersection of the steel upper deck with the vessel's sides by the Registro Italiano, but we are informed by them that the original deck line in accordance with the certificate of this Society has been allowed to remain.

The vessel has left Trieste and we are informed by the Registro Italiano that no freeboard certificates were issued by them in the case of the "RIALTO" at this time, but that this will be done on the vessel's return to Trieste.

It is noted that instructions for dealing with vessels to which Italian freeboards are now being assigned are being forwarded to Mr. Turnbull, the Society's Principal Surveyor for Italy.

A copy of our letter of the 12th instant regarding the "RIALTO" was sent to Mr. Turnbull, and a copy of this letter is also being forwarded to him.
