Dear Sir,

F. I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 22nd instant in connexion with the s.s."DEVA" now named "ZEPHYR", the contents of which have been noted.

As desired, I enclose a copy of the freeboard report on the case for your guidance in the freeboard survey, and I shall be glad to learn whether a timber freeboard assignment is now desired by the new Owners. If so, you should satisfy yourself that the condition of assignment for these freeboards is complied with as follows:

The bulwarks stays should be efficiently riveted to the stringer plate and the efficiency of the bulwarks should not be impaired by attaching the lashings for timber to the shackles in the bulwark stays.

On receipt of this information the new Load Line Certificates will be prepared and sent you for issue.

If the matter is urgent you should cable your reply.
