With reference to the case of Middlesbrough report No. 110077 regarding Freeboard assignment for the steamer "DEVA" of Barcelona (ex "LEVENSAU") at present at this port, I beg to inform you that the Bridge front iron doors have now been fitted with hinges and bolts not exceeding 6 inches apart.

A wood gangway supported on iron stanchions from the Forecastle deck to bridge deck for safe access of crew has also been fitted.

As these requirements are now in order will you please forward a re-assignment of vessel's freeboard and when markings have been verified a report will be forwarded.
