Dear Sirs,

I am in receipt of your freeboard report No. 11007 on the S.S. "LEVENSAU", and have to confirm the telegram which has been sent to you to-day as follows, namely,

"Levensau report details closing appliances bridge
"front whether permanently hinged steel doors or only
"portable plates if so state means securing same".

I have to point out that it is very important that the means of closing the openings in the end bulkhead on deck erections should be clearly described on the report form, in order that it may be seen whether such appliances fall under the description "permanent", "Class A" or "Class B" of the Board of Trade regulations, Circular 1416.
