We request that the Committee of Lloyd's Register will instruct the Society's Surveyors to Specially Survey during Construction the Hull, Engines and Boilers of the Vessel No. 347 building by Messrs. Lübecker Maschinenbau - Gesellschaft for Messrs. Knöke & Dunsford Wfz, Hamburg of 3300 Tons. Length 282'0" Breadth 44'0", Depth 19'0" intended to be Classed Lloyd's Register + 100 A1, strengthened for ice-navigation.

We undertake to arrange for every facility to be given to the Surveyors to carry out the duty in question, and we agree to pay the fees for the Surveyors' services, in addition to the actual travelling and other expenses incurred by the Surveyors in connection therewith.

This request is made upon the terms of the Rules and Regulations of Lloyd's Register of Shipping, which provide that:—
