Dear Mr. Watt,

Referring to the verification of Freeboard of the "BARBARIGO" reported on Genoa Report N°139II, dated 11/5/35, for Completion of Special Survey N°I, I have thought it well to forward a separate Verification Form Rpt.C.12 (a), as it appears that when the International Freeboard was first reported from Trieste in September 1932 (please see Trieste Report 8, N°9724 dated 29/9/32) a Verification Form was not then submitted, it being among the very earliest - reported from that port.

It does not appear that our Register Book has been altered.

I note that the R.I. have not so far altered their Book, this I understand through an oversight on their part.

The centre of disc and other marks are as now reported.

Incidentally I must state I cannot make the present Freeboard of 39 inches in our Book agree with the draught there given.
