Dear Sirs,

With reference to your letter of the 22nd instant, enclosing your report No. 8910 in respect of the freeboards for the motorship "BARBARIGO", Cantiere Navale Triesino's No. 221, I now send herewith the assignment letters giving the freeboards assigned to this vessel. It is assumed that certificates will be issued by the Registro Italiano in this case, but you should see that the freeboards marked on the vessel's sides are not less than those approved by the Committee, and forward the usual verification form giving the markings on the sides of the ship.

I have to request that you will forward, for record purposes, full particulars of the hatchways, hatches and supports on the second deck.

When the steel watertight cover closing the tonnage opening has been replaced by efficient temporary covers, on the vessel's return from her first voyage, you should give full particulars of the scuppers from the tween deck spaces.
