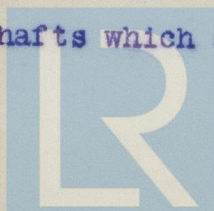
Dear Sir,

Herewith we acknowledge your letter of the 7th instant enclosing Freeboard Certificate, in duplicate, which will be issued to the Builders of Dredger "CHUN PING" in accordance with your instructions.

We enclose herewith a sketch showing the preparations being made for the contemplated voyage to China. We have to inform you that Mr. Munro, Senior Surveyor from Glasgow, has made a survey of the vessel and discussed the particulars in connection with the preparations being made.

It has been arranged that the jibs of the cranes will be lowered and securely fastened on deck.

Bagged coal will be carried in the hopper well on a temporary wood platform $2\frac{1}{2}$ " thick with a 2" space between planks to allow water to drain quickly, and the two after hopper doors will be left two inches open and held in place by their own chain gear (which will be locked and secured, in conjunction with steel wedges fitted in the opening, these wedges are fitted with shafts which are carried above the/

the water line at the hopper sides and there secured by fastenings direct to the hull of the vessel thereby holding the wedges in place and also allowing of their removal if necessary.

This is a duplicate of the arrangement carried out in the case of the ship Ship "RUKAMATI".

We trust that these particulars together with the notations upon the enclosed plan will give all the particulars desired.

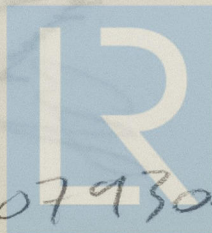
