I have to acknowledge the receipt of your letter of the 25th ultimo regarding the authorization of the Society to assign freeboards to Cuban ships in accordance with the International Load Line Convention on behalf of the Cuban Government and note from the copies of the correspondence forwarded that the Government reserve to themselves the right to assign freeboards to Cuban ships and that the surveys will be carried out by their own Surveyors.

The enclosures forwarded with your letter are returned herewith as desired.

With regard to the above you will recollect that this Society has already assigned freeboards and issued certificates on Form LL 3 in the cases of the steamers "W.E. OGILVIE" and "MANUEL RIONDA", and it is observed that the certificate for the former vessel will expire on the 31st August, 1935. You should therefore arrange for the certificate and copy to be returned to this Office for cancellation on expiration.

As regards the "MANUEL RIONDA" the certificate

is issued by the Cuban Authorities.

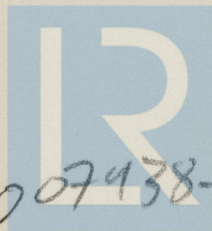
