Dear Sir,

I am in receipt of your verification of marking form in respect of the Oil Barge "MANUEL RIONDA", and with regard thereto have to inform you that as freeboard certificates under the 1906 regulations are no longer valid, it will be necessary, before certificates can be issued in respect of this ship, for a survey to be held in accordance with the International Convention regulations.

I therefore enclose for your information and guidance a memorandum of particulars taken from the previous freeboard report on this ship and shall be glad if you will forward the desired information on a Report Form C.11, together with the usual request form signed by the Owners.

I take this opportunity to refer to my letter of the 2nd instant relative to the question of this Society being authorized to assign freeboards and issue International Load Line Certificates to ships registered in Cuba on behalf of the Cuban Government, and await the receipt of your replied reply on the subject.
