"War Dirk", we beg to inform you that the frames  
tested in way of engine and boiler space were  
x 3'2 x 4'4 Bulbangle, the size given on midship  
section for frames in way of main deck.

All the framing sizes were given on this plan,  
modification of any kind was drawn attention to,  
the isolated note on profile plan was  
fortunately overlooked.

Your answer to your second query a satisfactory  
arrangement of blocks and tackle led to the after  
steam winch, was provided as an alternative  
means of steering. The scantlings of quadrant  
were also increased as required.
