Dear Sir,

We beg to enclose four copies of Certificate of Completion, Form 2, for the S.S. "War Dirk" built by the Caledon S.B. & Co. Ltd. of this port. It will be observed that the vessel has been accepted by the managing owners subject to the foremast being straightened and the specification requirements carried out as regards the testing of derricks. It was not possible to carry out the derrick test until the last moment, and when attempting to lift the test load of 6 tons with the No 2. derrick, the foremast gave slightly in way of the hinged portion at derrick table. Under the circumstances the test was not proceeded with. It being absolutely necessary that the vessel should leave directly after steam trial, the vessel was taken over as stated and has left to load at Blyth. It is impossible to say
