We have to inform you that the steamer "TERNEUZEN" is now in hand at this Port for re-classification survey and permanent repairs to damage caused through stranding on the coast of Portugal.

A list of the various repairs to be carried out has been forwarded to us by the Lisbon Surveyors.

We shall, however, be pleased to learn whether an examination has been held at Lisbon with a view to the 2nd special survey no.1, which became due in October 1937, and, further, if the list referred to above also includes the repairs necessary in connexion with the special survey.

According to a letter received from the Surveyors at Lisbon a fee of £ 125 will be charged, but will you kindly let us know whether the special survey fee is included in this amount.
