With reference to the specification for repairs, to the above named vessel, enclosed herewith, no mention is made of the opening up of machinery and boilers as this is being done by your staff.

We wish to mention that the survey for the repairs was conscientiously carried out but it is to be expected that other items may appear as repairs proceed.


