The Committee have had before them a report of General Examination of hull and machinery carried out by the Society's Surveyors at Sydney, N.S.W. (April '46 to June '46), with a view to postponement of the Special Survey until the vessel's arrival at Hong Kong.

In view of the satisfactory nature of this examination, the Committee have assigned a record of "Examined 6,46" valid for a period of six months and I have pleasure in enclosing the classification certificate herewith.

The Boiler Survey, due 10,43, has been carried out, and it is noted that the donkey boiler has not been surveyed and has been blanked off. In these circumstances the Committee have assigned the record of BS 6,46, and have given instructions for the record of donkey boiler pressure to be deleted from the Society's Register Book.
