Dear Sir,

I duly received your letter of the 10th May last respecting the steamer "KINTORE" and carefully note the advices you have received from the Australian Steamships Pty. Ltd. regarding the transfer of this vessel to the United States Authorities.

The vessel's present employment has also been noted and as there seems no likelihood of compliance with the outstanding Periodical Surveys, the Committee have given instructions for her class to be deleted from the Register Book.

As regards the "BULIMBA" referred to in your other letter of the 10th May, it is noted that the vessel is still registered in the name of the A.U.S.N. Co. Ltd. and that negotiations are proceeding in regard to sale to the United States Authorities.

The surveys in this case are not badly overdue and, in the circumstances, the Committee have deferred dealing with the class pending further information from you.

Please, therefore, keep the case in mind and report any developments.
