I have to refer to your letter of the 25th April
addressed to the Ministry's Agents at Harwich, Messrs. Groom & Son
(Harwich) Ltd., and to inform you that although this vessel has
been allocated to the Ministry of War Transport for service as a
waterboat she is still owned by the Admiralty and it is not proposed
to maintain her Lloyds' classification.

Steps have, however, been taken to re-register her at the
Port of Grimsby in the name of the Minister of War Transport under
the management of Stanley Lancelot Tottle of Messrs. Newton, Tottle
& Wilson Ltd., Exchange Buildings, Bowlalley Lane, Hull.
