Dear Sirs,

With reference to the case of the Trawler "CORCYRA," I beg to inform you that the particulars of this vessel were omitted from last year's Edition of the Register Book at the request of the Admiralty in view of the fact that at that time she was not expected to return to commercial service.

Information has now been received, however, to the effect that the Trawler has been transferred to the Ministry of War Transport, and it is understood she is to be managed by you.

In normal circumstances, her particulars would be re-entered in the Register Book but, as regards her class, she is now overdue for General Examination, Boiler Survey and Screwshaft Survey, and I shall be obliged if you will kindly let me know what are the Ministry's intentions as regards maintenance of class.

I would add that the reprint of the Trawlers section of the Register Book is now in hand, and it will, therefore, be appreciated if this matter can receive your early attention.
