Dear Sir,

With reference to the ^{3rd} 2nd Special Survey No.1 which became due on your steam trawler "CORCYRA" at the end of June last, I have to acquaint you that the Committee have had before them at their Meeting to-day, a report from the Society's Surveyors at Fleetwood, from which it appears that a satisfactory general examination has been carried out.

In the circumstances, the Committee have agreed to the vessel's class remaining undisturbed in the Register Book until the end of November, 1940 and she will be assigned a notation of "Examined 5:40", which will be duly posted in the Register Book.

I may add that the Surveyor reported that the metal of the condenser aft water end was found to be soft and he has recommended that it should be renewed before the end of October next
