Stranded on Bacton Beach

*It reported to have been refloated.
From later information it appears
vessel had not been refloated but
had been sold to the present owners
for £535. The Committee has
deferred action several times
pending receipt of further information.
The vessel was refloated during
August and taken to Lowestoft
for repairs.*

*From a statement drawn by
one of the Society's surveyors
it appears that it is the
intention to tow the vessel to
Yarmouth to be dry-docked
for examination; that as
far as can be seen afloat
the vessel has sustained very
little damage. The surveyor
has been given to understand
that the vessel has been
purchased by a Mr. Cunliffe
who intends to alter her into a yacht under the
survey of this Society.*
