Vessel stranded on *Raclen*  
*Beach* on 29 Sept. 1914 but was  
 reported to have been refloated.

A report however appeared in  
 the *Shipping Gazette* of 30 March  
 stating that the vessel had been sold  
 by auction to Messrs Harrison & Co for £535.

In reply to enquiries regarding the  
 classification of the vessel the new Owner  
 wrote on 14 April.

This vessel is ashore at present and  
 we intend salving same when  
 ready for repair. I have no doubt  
 you will have due notice.

Action has since been deferred  
 by the Committee pending the receipt of  
 further information from the Owner.

A further letter was sent to the  
 Owner on 24 June & no reply has been  
 received.

9th August 1915

Messrs. Crabtree of Great Yarmouth
