After careful consideration, we have decided to discontinue dual Hull & Machinery Classification on vessels of our fleet and we wish to advise that of our dual-classed vessels we desire that you retain the Classification of the M/V "LOUISIANA", M/V "FLORIDA", M/V "RHODE ISLAND" and the S/S "CONNECTICUT" and cancel your Classification effective as of today on the S/S "NEW JERSEY", S/S "WASHINGTON", S/S "OHIO" and S/S "OKLAHOMA".

The Freeboard assignments and certificates covering the above vessels are to remain in force as at present.

Effective as of this date, we also desire to cancel Classification of our Barge "MAGNOLIA".
