The RIO DE JANEIRO Surveyor reports (4.47) ship examined in dry dock, bottom coated, and on account of wear and tear renewals effected to shell plates C.3 & 10 and D.3,4,5,9 & 10 (p.s) and C.3 & 4 and D.4,8 & 9 (s.s). A few other repairs effected.

The side frames in hold and boiler room are reduced in thickness but efficient meantime, and the Surveyor recommends that they be dealt with at the next Special Survey.

It is submitted this ship is worthy to remain as classed, with record of docking 4.47, subject to side frames in hold and boiler room being dealt with at the next S.S.
