Dear Sirs,

With reference to the First Entry Report on the Machinery of the S.S. "ORTONA", recently completed by Messrs. R. Cock & Sons Ltd., at Appledore, and to your debit note of the 10th instant for £ 1: 4: 0, which amount ^{you state} is one-third of the Special fee for the Survey of the Engines to be credited to your account, I have to point out that the fee of £ 3:12: 0, entered on the London Report No. 81397, relating to the Engines of this vessel, is one-third of the total fee.

The proportion of the fee for the installation on board of the Machinery is also £ 3:12: 0 (one third of total fee) and is payable by the firm who fitted the Engines and Boiler on board, which in this case it is concluded will be the shipbuilders Messrs. R. Cock & Sons Ltd.,

As it would appear you have charged no fee for the fitting on board of the Machinery, an account should now be rendered for £ 3:12: 0, and this amount should be entered in your Rough Fee and Debit Books in the usual way.
