In the Yard of Messrs. N.V. Amsterdamse Droogdok Mij, Amsterdam is a Scotch Boiler (Single ended & 3 corrugated furnaces), which according to information received from them comes from the Steam Trawler "MEWSTONE" (no. 68197 in the R.B.).

This boiler has now been purchased by the Owners of the Finnish s.s. "EERO" (no. 57541 in the R.B.) and is intended to be fitted on board of this vessel.
